Finding comfort is a daily pursuit for all of us. Whether it's the solace of a quiet moment or the physical relief of a soft chair, comfort brings a sense of peace and calmness to our lives.

Yet, for those in our Palliative Care ward at St Vincent's Private Hospital Brisbane, comfort holds even greater significance. It becomes a beacon of hope amid the challenges they are experiencing.

Our Palliative care service is a person centred, comprehensive service for people living with progressive, life limiting disease, with the aim of improving their quality of life. Care that includes but is not limited to, symptom and pain management and end of life care.

Our caring and compassionate staff work daily with each patient to identify and treat their symptoms, which may be a combination of physical, emotional, spiritual, and social. By doing this we are optimising each of our patient's quality of life during this very trying time.

Currently, many of our Palliative Care patients struggle to find relief in standard hospital beds due to pain or breathing difficulties. Currently in our Palliative care ward, we have 40 beds for those in need, but only a small amount of them have access to a recliner chair. With your generosity, we aim to acquire ten more specialized recliners at \$1,350 each. These chairs not only benefit patients but can also provide respite for their loved ones who help care for them during their final moments. Your donation will ensure that those in our care can find solace and peace during such challenging times.

#### Recliner chairs are beneficial to our Palliative care patients in three ways:

- 1. They assist those who may have trouble lying in bed with their breathing. By having an option to sit in an upright position it provides them with an opportune way of taking a breath.
- **2**. **Can reduce pressure sores.** Providing a way to change positions in an air cushioned chair, helps reduces these issues.
- 3. Provide a sense of home. Being in hospital can be a stressful situation, so a feeling of normality by having a supportive and comfortable chair, that they may have at their own home, can reduce some of that stress.

Ellen Hocking one of our Senior Occupational Therapists recently mentioned to me.

"Recliner chairs are very helpful for those experiencing shortness of breath, as often it is much more comfortable and supportive for breathing to be in a more upright position. The chairs allow patients to participate more actively in each day. By having an option to be able to sit up out of bed while still feeling comfortable and supported, the patient is able to feel more engaged with those around them".
